UPGRADING YOUR NEW FOREST TO A BLACK EDITION

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

- Phillips cross head screw driver
- Flat blade screw driver
- Gloves
- Deluxe log fuel bed
- Rear dark glass
- AR glass



IMPORTANT NOTES

The appliance **MUST** be completely cool before any work is to be carried out.

Before any work is carried out, the appliance **MUST** be turned off and unplugged from the wall.



PLEASE ENSURE THE PRODUCT IS TURNED OFF

WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT PROTECTIVE GLOVES ARE WORN WHEN HANDLING THE GLASS

1) To remove the front glass from the appliance, use a cross headed screw driver to remove the screws from either end of the glass retaining bracket.

Ensure the glass is supported at all times.



- 2) Next, gently lever the top of the glass towards you, ensuring you have full support of the glass.
- **3)** Lift the glass up and out from the appliance and place the glass on a soft. flat surface on the floor.



4) Remove the cross head screws that hold the fuel bed into position, then carefully remove the fuel bed tray and logs from the appliance and place safely to one side. A flat head screw driver can carefully be used to lever the fuel bed out if extra help is required.



We strongly recommend using protective gloves when removing the glass.

5) Remove the side glass by carefully moving the bottom of the side glass inwards, releasing the glass from the sides of the appliance. Repeat on the opposite side.

Ensure the glass is supported at all times.



We strongly recommend using protective gloves when removing the glass.

6) If this is not possible, remove the screws from the bracket holding the side glass in place. Then carefully remove the glass from each side.

Ensure the glass is supported at all times.



7) Remove the mirrored rear glass from rear of the appliance by carefully offering the bottom of the glass out at the bottom then the top.



8) If this is not achievable, remove the 2x rear clamps, from the rear of the appliance. The carefully remove the rear glass.



9) Remove the dark glass from the packaging.

Ensure the dark glass is in the correct orientation. The reflective side faces forwards and the matt finished side faces the rear of the appliance. Carefully insert the top of the rear glass into the top of the firebox, behind the top glass retaining brackets (if not previously removed).

Once the top is in place, push the bottom of the rear glass towards the fire, in an upright position.





10) Then re-install the 2x rear clamps

(if previously removed) to secure the rear glass.



11) Carefully insert both side AR glass panels back into each side of the appliance, in at the top first behind the side glass retaining brackets (if not previously removed) in at the bottom, then make sure it is pushed back against the rear glass.





12) Screw the top clamps from each side back into position, holding the side glass in place, if previously removed.



13) Carefully place the Deluxe fuel bed tray into position and ensure the fuel bed tray is back against the rear glass, so a gap is created at the front of the fuel bed.

Tip; It might help to insert the Deluxe fuel bed tray in at an angle.



14) Carefully lift the AR front glass up and into the bottom front grooves of the appliance, then in at the top.



15) Using a cross headed screw driver, insert the firebox screws back through either ends of the glass retaining bracket and into the appliance, securing the front glass into place.

The upgrade is now complete
